Ben Livneh: these many voices in the river (2024)

This piece deals with subjectivity. Especially with respect to the meaning—or lack thereof—of spoken language.

Zesheng Fan: Fibre

This is introduction of my piece "Fibre". "Fibre" is one of the eight instruments, referring to the zither, whose strings are made of fibre. The work itself is based on the theme of "fibre", a traditional Chinese material, which symbolizes delicacy, flexibility and connection.

The composer created around the B note, and expressed the "fibre"-like image by using various sound processing and the hierarchical structure of music. The delicate sound effects produced by the inter-locking of notes are also the embodiment of "fibre"
