it is a journey from the real world to a surreal world and consists of three movements. This cycle starts ambiguously and is then followed by ongoing pulsation which streams attraction and repulsion. Overwhelmingly, it is continued and elaborated so far that listeners drown in narrow space, tolerance between tension and wideness, black and white, light and darkness. The second movement led the listener to a contemplation mood. Facing a steady pulse of familiar chord progression, which synthesizing with microtone, pictured an illusionary scene, blurred feelings of being in an unreal space end up emerging a short motive which spread. The third movement floats in the surreal atmosphere that moves between silence and melody to narrate the dimension of to be and return to reality.
